Overall Dimensions of Vehicle and Load

- Width up to 10 ft., Height 13 ft. 6 in., Length up to 70 ft. – Fee \$100.00 quarterly or \$400.00 annually
- Width up to 12 ft., Height 13 ft. 6 in., Length up to 115 ft. – Fee \$150.00 quarterly or \$600.00 annually
- Width up to 16 ft., Height 13 ft. 6 in., Length up to 115 ft. – Fee \$250.00 quarterly or \$1,000.00 annually

ESCORTS: One civilian escort is required for all moves that 1) exceed 14 ft. 6 in. wide, or 2) exceed 110 ft. long. Two civilian escorts, one in front of load and one in rear, are required for all moves that are both greater than 14 ft. 6 in. wide and 110 ft. long.

Bottom frame must be equipped with operational brakes and lights.

Movement is valid on the system of state highways under the jurisdiction of the Department of Transportation. The permittee is required to move only on the state routes approved for loads that do not exceed practical maximum weights (see Section 554.604). Before each move, the permittee must research construction zones, posted structures, approved overweight routes, etc. from the following resources: <http://www.dot.il.gov/tpublic.html#truckers>, www.gettingaroundillinois.com. **All movements must be made strictly in compliance with OPER 993 Special Vehicle Movement Permit Provisions applying as if fully written herein.** The permit and OPER 993 provision sheet must be carried in the vehicle and must be available for inspection by police or department officials. The permit may not be transferred, extended or altered. The vehicle may not exceed the posted limit on any bridge.
