2003 Illinois Aviation Hall of Fame Inductees

Larry Byerly, Oliver Boyd Clow, and the Moody Brothers were inducted into the Illinois Aviation Hall of Fame for 2003. They were presented their awards at the Illinois Aviation Hall of Fame Banquet held in conjunction with the Illinois Aviation Conference. Following is a biographical sketch of the winners and their accomplishments.

Larry B. Byerly – a lifelong Peorian. He grew up in the family owned aviation business, which his Illinois Hall of Fame father, R. Millard Byerly, started on the old grass Mt. Hawley Airport, Peoria, IL, more than seven decades ago.

Byerly has been president of Byerly Aviation since 1968. He has shown time and time again that his generosity and dedication to the aviation industry are sincere and heartfelt. Byerly has helped many people obtain careers in the aviation industry who may not otherwise have had the means.

Byerly is an advocate of college internship programs. He allows interns, with an interest in aviation,

to work for Byerly Aviation in Peoria. He also finances a scholarship through the aviation program at Southern Illinois University, where he is a member of the Aviation Advisory Committee. Numerous Byerly Aviation employees have continued in their aviation careers to become corporate pilots, airline pilots and maintenance technicians. Larry Byerly is a respected member of the Peoria community, and the aviation community around the world.

Oliver Boyd Clow – started Clow International Airport in Bolingbrook, IL, in the 1950s. Through hard work and perseverance he helped the airport become home to a variety of general aviation aircraft. Over the years he has been a steadfast advocate for general aviation in Illinois. If there was someone on the field who could not afford to rent a plane to learn how to fly he would offer the use of his Cessna 150. Warbirds, experimental aircraft, ultralights, helicopters, gliders and wing walkers are all welcome.

However, there was a time when the pressures of urban sprawl threatened to close the airport, because it was surrounded by land ideal for industrial development. To assure the survival of his airport Clow spent three years developing alternate plans. He was successful in negotiating to keep the airport open and to create a prosperous relationship with the surrounding community.

He recently donated a Piper Aztec to the Experimental Aviation Association (EAA) aviation foundation to aid young aviators in their quest to discover the joys of flying. To know Boyd Clow is to know flying. Clow's contribution to Illinois aviation is not in a form that is dramatic, instead, it is a form that is inspiring.

The Moody Brothers –When Charles Lindbergh made his famous flight in 1927, Hunter Moody, the elder of two sons born to farmer Edward Moody and wife Ethel, of Dalton City, IL, became fascinated with flight. At the age of 14 he asked his father if he could take flying lessons.

Hunter soloed after 15 hours and received his instructor rating by the age of sixteen 16. He taught his father, younger brother Humphrey and other members of his family and community how to fly.

When the brothers acquired a TriMotor Ford they barnstormed across the state, selling rides and using a siren to alert the rural town folk of their arrival. In 1934, Hunter leased the Bearsdale Airport, Decatur, IL, where he offered flight instruction and charter service.

In June of 1939, Hunter tried to break the world endurance record of 218 hours of flying in a light aircraft. He almost succeeded, but was forced down due to engine failure.

There is great value in venturing forth into new aircraft ratings. How about getting some training in a sailplane, rotorcraft or balloon? Continuing your aviation training is absolutely the best insurance one can get to guarantee a lifetime of good flying habits and techniques.

In this, the 100th year of aviation, it is great that the National Air Tour will be returning to its historic roots in Illinois. From the period of 1925-1931 Illinois provided annual stops for this aviation-building event.

Lansing Municipal Airport will be one of the first stops for National Air Tour 2003, a 4000 mile, and 26 city odyssey for over 25 vintage aircraft. Lansing (then Chicago-Hammond), hosted a stop on the 1927 Ford Air Tour. At that time a feature was its then new Ford Aircraft Hangar (which currently is on the National Register of Historic Places).

On Sept. 9, 2003, the Lansing ramp and skyline should feature Sikorsky Flying Boats, Ford and Stinson Trimotors, and a number of other aircraft from aviation's formative *Roaring '20s*. This should be a great opportunity to see aviation history—in the air and not in a museum. Decatur Airport named 2003 Primary Airport of the Year

During a special ceremony at the 2003 Illinois Aviation Conference, Decatur Airport was named the 2003 Primary Airport of the Year. This award is based on outstanding work in the areas of airport maintenance, community support, and the promotion of aviation.

Decatur Airport managed a total of 55,531 operations in 2002, and has already seen an increase in operations for 2003. They have 126 based aircraft ranging from single engines to helicopters. Additionally, the airport offers free parking and a business center for passenger convenience.

Airline service at the airport includes three roundtrip flights to St Louis provided by Trans States/American Connection. Departure times include 5:43 a.m., 1:20 p.m., and 6:05 p.m. Arrivals come in at 12:50 p.m., 5:33 p.m., and 10:06 p.m. Travel is on 30 passenger Jet Stream 41.

The airport has numerous flying clubs and organizations. These include Decatur Aero Club, EAA Loren Hodge Chapter #274, Touch and Go Flying Club, and Vagabond Flight Corporation. All of these organizations help to add value to Decatur Airport.

The Division of Aeronautics would like to extend their congratulations to Decatur Airport for all their outstanding efforts.

On July 23, 1939, after Humphrey completed his private license, he and Hunter installed a new engine in the plane. They set out from Springfield Airport in the *Miss Springfield* to attempt the record once more. Although forced to land by an electrical storm, the brothers exceeded the record by flying 343:46.

With threat of war brewing in Europe, the brothers became flight instructors and prepared cadets for wartime flying missions; both later became captains in the 45th Group of the Royal Air Force. After World War II, Humphrey continued instructing under the GI Bill at Moody Farm Airport, Dalton City, IL, until it was closed in 1952.
