Procedures for Testing and Approval

Effective: April 1, 2011

A. Scope

Before materials can be used for a Department project, the producer/supplier must be on the Approved List for Certified Sources of Reclaimed Asphalt Shingle (RAS) Source. The following guidelines are provided to clarify the submittal requirements and expedite the process.
